In the main cities, however, it is common with a mix of public and private suppliers. The services delivered by non-profit private suppliers very often gain better evaluation than services deliverers both by private for-profit and public providers. The hypothesis put forward in the project is that the non-profit providers work under different conditions, leaving more room for creativity facilitating quality in care than both the for-profit and public providers. To explore these external conditions, we will investigate both the governing process and the governing tools used and by the municipalities; and the leadership within each of the studied nursing homes.
	The study concentrates on services in long term care - in nursing homes.
